# **Operational Budget Timeline**

#### What is an Operational Budget

The operational budget is the largest of the five subsections of the state budget. The operational budget funds the Education, Health, human service, corrections, most state agencies, the Legislature and the Judiciary. Ohio renews its operating budget every two years. The state's fiscal year runs from July 1 to June 30.

### **Governor** (Jan-February)

Governor Proposes 2-Year State
Budget to the House of Representatives

### **Conference Committee (Mid June)**

Conference Committee creates a bill that combines the House and Senate amendments. This is voted on by House and Senate. When both pass the bill it is sent to the Governor

### House (February-April)

Committees propose, accept or reject amendments. House votes on the amendments and passes House Budget, which is sent to Senate

### Senate (April-June)

Members makes amendments which is voted on and sent to Conference Committee.

Governor (June 30)

Governor signs the budget into law
