Below are just a few of the bills that Rep. Bird has introduced or passed so far in the 134th General Assembly. These are smart, common sense pieces of legislation that preserve conservative family values and support our local communities throughout Ohio.

HB 67 - Supporting Ohio Students

Waived the state-only testing requirements for the 2020-2021 school year.

HB 340 - Respecting Ohio's History

Establishes September as "International Underground Railroad Month" and acknowledges the significance of the Underground Railroad and abolitionists in Ohio.

HB 170 - Providing Schools COVID-19 Relief

Provided approximately \$857 million in federal funding to Ohio's public, private and vocational schools for COVID-19 pandemic-related expenses.

HB 220 - Creating College Scholarships

Creates a specialty license plate that provides funds for yearly college scholarships.

HR 138 - Remembering Doug Green

Honors former State Representative Doug Green for his service.

HB 250 - Honoring Local Law Enforcement

Designates a portion of State Route 32 in Batavia Township as the "Deputy Bill Brewer Memorial Highway" in honor of Deputy Sheriff William Lee "Bill" Brewer, Jr.

HR 57- Urges to "Keep Nine"

Urges the protection of the integrity and independence of the U.S. Supreme Court from the recent Executive Order to study the expansion of the number of justices.

Rep. Bird supported a number of solid bills during his first year in office. Below are just a few:

- H.B. 128 - Revises electric utility service law & repeals portions of H.B. 6
- H.B. 149 - Requires certain judicial candidates to have party designation on the ballot
- S.B. 157 - Enacts the Born Alive Protection Act to save a child born after a failed abortion attempt
- H.B. 227 - Protects Ohioans' 2nd Amendment rights to "Constitutional Carry"
- H.B. 99 - Permits Ohio schools to arm certain & qualified staff and faculty to enhance school safety
- S.B. 22 - Allows for legislative oversight of the Governor's executive health orders
- H.B. 218 - Enacts the Ohio Medical Freedom Plan to prohibit mandatory COVID-19 vaccine mandates or passports
- S.B. 1 - Requires financial literacy in Ohio high schools
- H.C.R. 5 - Urges Congress to reject federally run elections & gives power to the states



This year, we passed House Bill 110, the State Operating Budget for F.Y. 2022-2023. Below are just a few of the highlights included in this year's historic budget:

Putting Students First

This historic legislation reforms public school funding and empowers more parents in the education of their children than ever before. The Fair School Funding Plan, a result of more than three years of work by educators and policymakers, puts students first. This comprehensive funding formula is based on the costs of providing a quality education. It is rational, predictable and sustainable.

Cutting Taxes

The bill includes a 3% across the board personal income tax cut. The bill also reduces the number of tax brackets from five to four, and eliminates the income tax for anyone making less than \$25,000 per year. Overall, these and other tax changes in the budget reduce taxes \$2 billion over the biennium. This is the result of good fiscal management, protecting tax dollars and prioritizing state spending.

Keeping and Creating Jobs

The plan includes important reforms to help make Ohio more competitive with other states so Ohio can keep the jobs it has and attract new jobs, new investment and new opportunity. It also provides \$155 million to help industries recover from the COVID-19 pandemic.

Standing With Our Veterans, Law Enforcement and First Responders

We are proud to stand in support of those who have protected our freedoms and served our communities: Ohio's veterans, law enforcement and first responders. This budget includes funding for training and equipment, as well as support for veterans organizations.

Expanding Broadband & Opportunity

Broadband is the infrastructure of today and our future. Broadband continues to connect people with economic and educational opportunities and more. The historic commitment to broadband included in the new state budget will expand opportunity in neighborhoods and communities across Ohio.
